


**Drainage District 2**  
**Matagorda County, Texas**  
**February 12, 2020**

Persons present included Drainage District 2 Commissioners Mark Lezak and David Bradley. There was one guest, Allen Cumbie, Drainage District 2 Attorney. Mark Lezak called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The minutes of the January 8, 2020 meeting were read and approved on a motion by David Bradley and second by Mark Lezak.

- Allen Cumbie will contact Andrew Caplan and try to get a quote from one of Chris Rinkers contractors on completing the level control pipe installation on Jennings Lake. One of the pipes washed out during the last rain and Rinker would like to reinstall the pipe and complete the job himself with his own contractor.
- David Bradley reported that he will have a contractor clean a ditch south of Hoffman Road #417 west of Markham in the near future.
- McDonald Equipment is cleaning the Tommy Phillips ditch north of the Williams Plant and will also install a 30" pipe crossing in the ditch.
- David Bradley made a motion to purchase a new Polaris side by side and trailer since the previous Polaris and trailer were stolen back in November of 2019. Mark Lezak second and the motion passed. Polaris - \$22,700, Trailer - \$2620.
- The financial report dated 1/31/20 as received from Ellen Dodd was reviewed.
- The investment report dated 1/24/20 as received from the county treasurer Loretta Griffin was reviewed.
- David Bradley moved to pay the bills, Mark Lezak second and the motion passed.

There was general discussion concerning the district.

There being no further business, mark Lezak moved that the meeting be adjourned, David Bradley second and the motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:53 pm.
