


**Drainage District 2**  
**Matagorda County, Texas**  
**August 11, 2021**

Persons present included Drainage District 2 Commissioners Mark Lezak, Tony Kacer, and David Bradley. There were 2 guests, Allen Cumbie and Lewis Griffith. Mark Lezak called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The minutes of the July 14, 2021 meeting were read and approved on a motion by David Bradley second by Tony Kacer.

- David Bradley reported that he will have McDonald Equipment start cleaning Long Mott Creek from Murphy Road to Highway 35.
- The commissioners and Allen Cumbie had a discussion on the Electrical Line Application that Allen presented. This application will be used for Solar and Wind Farms that will possibly cross drainage structures in the future. The commissioners all agreed that the lines should be buried at a minimum of 6 feet and signage should be placed at every crossing. Allen will modify the application with all safety precautions added and send to the commissioners for review.
- The Tax Assessor did not have the Tax Rates prepared in time for this meeting. A special call meeting will have to be held to review the budget worksheet and vote on a proposed tax rate.
- The financial report dated 7/31/21 as received from Ellen Dodd was reviewed.
- The investment report dated 7/21/21 as received from the county treasurer Loretta Griffin was reviewed.
- David Bradley moved to pay the bills, Tony Kacer second and the motion passed.

There was a general discussion concerning the district.

There being no further business, David Bradley moved that the meeting be adjourned, Tony Kacer second and the motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm.
