

**Drainage District 2  
Matagorda County, Texas  
February 14, 2024**

Persons present included Drainage District 2 Commissioners Tony Kacer, Mark Lezak, and Jerome Vacek. There were 2 guests, Dwight Vavra with the Matagorda County Conservation Reclamation District #1, and James Kinard of Bay City. Mark Lezak called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The minutes of the January 10, 2024 meeting were read and approved on a motion by Tony Kacer and second by Jerome Vacek.

- Jerome Vacek is in the beginning stages of cleaning the Long Mott Creek from Highway 35 to the Colorado River but is unable to get permission to access the Rusty Green property. The Matagorda County Conservation Reclamation District is also trying to get access to the Green property in order to remove the trees and brush from the protection levee. Dwight Vavra, Chairman of the Conservation Reclamation District, said he will work with Drainage District #2 in trying to gain access to the Rusty Green property and also the cleaning of the Long Mott Creek which runs through the protection levee. Allen Cumbie, the Drainage District #2 Attorney, will send a letter to Rusty Green requesting permission to access his property and clean the Long Mott Creek and also the protection levee.
- Tony Kacer is working on getting drop pipes installed for Gary Saha on his Clemville property.
- Mark Lezak reported that Lewis Griffith completed the cleaning of the Trull ditch north of the Dow Plant in Clemville.
- Jerome Vacek will have a contractor clean the ditch north of the Williams Plant on the Tommy Phillips property north of Markham.
- Jerome Vacek is planning to drive through the Forrest Wyle property and inspect some ditches in the near future
- The financial report dated 2/3/24 as received from Ellen Dodd was reviewed.
- The investment report dated 2/8/24 as received from the county treasurer Loretta Griffin was reviewed.
- Tony Kacer moved to pay the bills, Mark Lezak second and the motion passed.

There was general discussion concerning the district.

There being no further business, Tony Kacer moved that the meeting be adjourned, Mark Lezak second and the motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:13 pm.
